

Please be sure that your paper is properly anonymized for the double blind peer review process.

Format the document for an A4 page with 20mm margins. All text should be in Times New Roman, 12 point, double-spaced. Please use UK English throughout (using the Oxford English Dictionary as a reference where necessary). Do not indent any part of the document excepting the abstract (to be headed Abstract) and quotations exceeding 100 words in length.

The essay is to be headed with the title and subtitle separated by a paragraph return.

Separate headings and paragraphs with double returns. Lines may be set to single spacing. Do not use bold or underlined text, or italics for emphasis. Italicise titles of books and journals.

References will appear in footnotes, formatted according to the 16th edition of the Chicago Manual of Style (Chapter 14), available online at www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/16/ch14/ch14_toc.html. No separate bibliography will be published. (Also see below for footnote form.)

Documents are to be clear of all extraneous formatting and data fields (eg Endnote). The Editors will return final accepted papers for the author's further attention should this not be the case.

Images

For the full paper review round, images should be embedded within the paper, which should be saved as a pdf file. A page at the end of the document should list image captions and credits. Further directions on image submission for the conference proceedings will be forwarded to authors after the peer review process is finished.

Note that the OCPMS website has a file size limit of 10MB. Larger files will need to be compressed before uploading.

For the conference proceedings, authors are responsible for securing permission and paying necessary fees in order to reproduce any image that will appear in the conference proceedings. A copy of all permissions must be submitted to the Editors for our records. Images not accompanied by verification of permission to publish (where not free of restriction) will not be published in the proceedings.

General

Dates are to be shown as 6 July 2016 (except in notes, where the CMS should be followed). Consistent with *Fabrications*, quotations are in the “first instance to use double marks, with ‘single’ marks to be used for embedded quotations.”¹ Queries concerning further details may be directed to conference co-conveners AnnMarie Brennan (brea@unimelb.edu.au) or Philip Goad (p.goad@unimelb.edu.au)
